DOCKING UNION WORKHOUSE PROJECT **2020-21**

Using the census returns, register transcripts and other available records volunteers have undertaken a project to identify the inmates and staff of the Docking Union Workhouse from 1841-1911.

The first page is a list as prepared by the enumerator at the time of the census. There follows a series of mini biographies of the staff and inmates.

It should be noted that the enumerator may have recorded people incorrectly because they were either unsure themselves of their facts, such as date and place of birth, or unable to provide the necessary details through age, impairment or illness. Where possible they have been researched and recorded correctly but some people have been impossible to identify beyond what was recorded on the day.

The date of this census was 3rd April 1881.

The original copies of the census return data we have consulted are held by **The National Archives** (reference RG10/ 1992).
